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## NEW EMISSION INSPECTOR LICENSE PACKET

### NRS 445B.705

"Approved Inspector" means a person licensed by the Department of Motor Vehicles to inspect motor vehicles and devices for the control of pollution for an authorized station or authorized inspection station. NRS 445B.705

#### Prerequisites:

1. A new Inspector License packet must be completed in its entirety and brought with the applicant to a local DMV Emission Lab before a practical exam can be scheduled.
2. A Pre-Practical Checklist (EC-30) must be signed by the Instructor and the Applicant.
3. All training requirements must be met.

Signatures must be notarized or witnessed by an Authorized DMV Representative.

Note: No required documentation can be completed during class.

#### Licensing Requirements:

1. Prerequisites must be completed.
2. Certificate of Employment: (OBL236) must be completed and signed by a principal or authorized representative of a licensed Nevada Emission Station. A new Certificate of Employment must be submitted any time changes are made to an existing license.
3. Personal History Questionnaire (OBL242) must be completed by the applicant to include a complete five year employment history with no breaks in employment, complete addresses, zip codes, telephone numbers, arrest record, disposition of charges, copy of discharge if ever under supervision, parole, or probation, and child support information.
4. One photograph of applicant. Photo must be no larger than 2" x 2", full face, shoulders and above, no sunglasses or hats.
5. The Advisory form (EC45) explains possible grounds for denial, suspension or revocation.
6. License fee of \$26.00 for first location and \$11.00 for each additional location; a technology fee is included.
7. Class 1 and Class 2 inspectors must comply with provisions of NAC 445B.485 in areas of training, qualifications, experience, and pass required examination(s) administered by the Department.
8. A Certificate of Training or an Automotive Service Excellence Certificate.

**Note: Applicants must check-in at the Occupational and Business Licensing counter prior to 4:00 pm in order to have a same day transaction completed.**
